*Be sure to have at least **one phone** aboard your boat with **WhatsApp** installed. Group communications will be sent via this app throughout the event.

PRE-DEPARTURE CHECKLIST:

- Ensure you have **safety gear** required, including life jackets for each passenger.
- Ensure you have purchased a **Bahamas Courtesy Flag & the Yellow Quarantine Flag**.
- Ensure every passenger has a **valid passport**.
- Make sure you have obtained a **PCR (Trip) number** from Bimini Customs & Immigration **IN ADVANCE** (it can take 48 hours to receive this number) to ensure no issues entering Bimini through their Click to Clear (C2C) system. You must have a PCR number prior to departing for Bimini.
- Make sure you have **cash** on hand for fees, permits, etc. required by Customs and Immigration.

- VHF Channel: Channel 67 (Ship-to-Ship use)

ARRIVAL IN BIMINI:

- Channel coordinates to **North Bimini entrance** for your GPS
 - N 25° 42.60
 - W 79° 18.48

RETURNING TO THE U.S.:

- Download the **CBP ROAM** app on your phone
- If your vessel is **30' or longer**, you must purchase a **CBP User Fee Decal** online. Purchase [here](#).
- Ensure everyone on board the vessel has a valid, up-to-date **passport readily available**.
- Upon arrival in the U.S., **report your arrival** via the CBP ROAM app.
- CBP will perform a **Face-to-Face Check**. A CBP officer will review your submission and you digitally via a video call or direct you to the nearest Port of Entry for inspection.
