# **Pre-Trip Guide**

## **GUIDE TO BIMINI, BAHAMAS CUSTOMS & IMMIGRATION CLEARANCE**

- All visiting boaters MUST CLEAR CUSTOMS AND IMMIGRATION on arrival.
- Customs and immigration are available on property.
- As you enter port, fly the yellow quarantine flag.
- Once docked, Captain & all Passengers are permitted to leave the boat and MUST clear the boat and crew with local customs and immigration immediately.
  - Only the Captain will present immigration officers with every person's passport and immigration card.

### **GUIDE TO CUSTOMS CLEARANCE \*PRIOR TO ARRIVAL\***

- Customs clearance is now done electronically, through the CLICK2CLEAR (C2C) system.
- For more information on the Click2Clear system, click <u>here</u>.
- All boaters have to Clear Customs prior to entering the Bahamas and OBTAIN A PCR NUMBER through the Click2Clear system (C2C).
- To obtain a PCR number, click <u>here</u>.
- First-time users of C2C are required to register online first. To register, click here.
- Required Documentation to obtain a PCR Number
  - Maritime Declaration Form
  - Inward Report Form
  - Bahamas Custom's Clearance Form
  - To download required documentation, click *here*.
- Upon arrival, the vessel Captain needs to present themselves with the PCR number at the Customs location.

#### **GUIDE TO IMMIGRATION CLEARANCE**

- Every person entering the Bahamas must have a VALID PASSPORT.
- Every person entering the Bahamas must fill out and sign an IMMIGRATION CARD.
  - Immigration Cards will be provided by the marina staff upon arrival.
- Completion of INWARD PASSENGER & CREW MANIFEST form which is filled out by the captain upon arrival.
- Before leaving the Bahamas, every visitor has to return their copy of the immigration card to the dockmaster.
